

استبيان تقييم احتياجات مصانع الإنارة الوطنيةSurvey to assess the needs of National Lighting Factories

Jordan Standards and Metrology Organization (JSMO), supported by the World Bank/ International Finance Corporation (within the project "Jordan National Quality Infrastructure Improvement"), is conducting an assessment of the National lighting factories' needs (producers) for the testing service of performance requirements and energy efficiency of directional lamps and luminaires.

This information will help assessing the demand of the National lighting factories' (producers) for this testing service and support improvement of the service, which should stimulate development of Jordanian production and export.

Please kindly answer the following questions:

1. Does your company manufacture lighting equipment, such as bulbs, luminaires and directional lamps (i.e. spotlights)? (Please specify the types)

2. Do you need to test the performance requirements and energy efficiency of your products? If so, for what purpose (i.e. regulatory requirements, consumers preferences, to prove competitiveness, tax exemptions, etc.)

3. How often do you test your products for performance requirements and energy efficiency? (per year per a type of product, and total for the company).

4. If the company sells on the domestic market, who are the main consumers (retail, municipalities, government) and what are the requirements to the compliance with standards (which standards) and to the conformity assessment (for example, declaration of conformity or third party).

5. If the company exports outside Jordan – to which countries, who are main consumers and what are the requirements to the compliance with standards (which standards) and to the conformity assessment (for example, declaration of conformity or third party).

6. Are the requirements to compliance and conformity assessment the same for Jordanian market and export? If not, what is the difference?

7. How the company assesses conformity with standards? By self-conducted tests, or by a third-party conformity assessment? Do you use your own laboratory or third parties providers?

8. If a company uses its own laboratory – is it accredited and by whom? What types of tests are available?

9. If a company uses third parties providers – who are these providers, are they accredited and by whom, what types of tests are available? Are these providers local or foreign? What is the cost of tests?

10. If the testing services are not available in Jordan, would such availability help the company? For example, by reducing the time or cost of tests? Is it important for your products competitiveness?
